Ordering your child's lunches and payments are to be made via Schoolgrid. **Please note - children's meals MUST be paid for in advance, unless you have set up a direct debit with Schoolgrid.**

Special Dietary Requirements - Please be advised that if your child has any special dietary requirements, you will need to apply for a special menu for your child directly through Hertfordshire Catering Limited (HCL).
