This week we have noticed that many of our Year 3 children are finding telling the time





The small hand shows how many hours the day has lasted.

We call this the hour hand.

This is 1 o'clock



The minute hand tells us how many minutes past (or to) each hour.

The hour hand tells us how many hours since 12 o'clock.

Time to learn how to read and use both hands together.

O'clock

When the minute hand is pointing to the 12, we count the time in whole hours.



Remember to look at the hour hand.

Half past

When 30 minutes have passed and the minute hand is pointing to the 6, we say:

half past ½ past



The hour hand will also be half way between numbers.

Be sure you read the number that the hour hand has passed!

When 15 minutes have passed and the minute hand is pointing to 3, we say:

quarter past 1/4 past



Remember to read the number that the hour hand has passed!

quarter to 1/4 to
