Re: Year 6 Residential Trip to Wildchild Adventure

We have planned a new and exciting residential trip for our Year 6 children to go to Wildchild Adventure. We are offering your child the opportunity to take part in the trip next year from **Sunday 9**th **July to Wednesday 12**th **July 2023.**

Wildchild Adventure endeavour to create lasting, positive experiences for pupils as each day brings new adventures and new challenges to overcome. There is a huge range of exciting adventure activities to help pupils build confidence, learn new skills and strengthen friendships.

The accommodation provided is as follows:

- **Pupil Tents:** Each bell-tent sleeps six children in comfortable bunk beds. There's coir matting underfoot throughout to keep everyone warm and dry. Under the beds, there's plenty of room to store belongings.
- Motion-sensored lighting system: Automatically comes on when anyone gets out of bed.
- Night Toilets: Close so everyone can happily use the facilities whenever they need them.
- **Sheltered Areas**: Ample sheltered spots for students/staff to use and a seating area with woodland benches for relaxing around the campfire.
- **Chill-out area:** Full of games for students to enjoy. They will love the upcycled table tennis tables and giant versions of favourite family games. There's plenty to keep them engaged.

To fuel young guests during a long day of thrilling adventure activities, the children will be served three hot meals per day, with lots of choice and seasonal variations. Each day there is a carefully balanced nutritional meal plan, recently updated to meet and exceed the latest Government standards on children's meals.

The trip is only offered to Year 6 children and is on a 'first come, first served basis'. To secure a place for your child, please read the terms and conditions below and then consent/make the non-refundable deposit of £50.00 via Schoolgateway by Friday 14th October 2022.

Please note the following terms, conditions and deadlines for payments:

- Deposit of £50.00 (non-refundable) paid via Schoolgateway by Friday 14th October 2022.
- Second payment of £150.00 Payment may be made by instalments, minimum payment of £10, provided the amount of £150 is paid via Schoolgateway by <u>Tuesday 28th February 2023.</u>
- Should you need to arrange an extension to the payment schedule I must request that a total of £200 must be received by Friday 31st March 2023 or we will assume that your child is NO longer participating in the trip.
- **Final payment of £125.00** Payment may be made by instalments, minimum payment of £10, provided the amount of £125 is paid via Schoolgateway by <u>Wednesday 31st May 2023.</u>

Children will be unable to take part in this trip without full payment being made by the deadline of Wednesday 31st May 2023.

Please may I also make you aware of the cancellation charging structure which Wildchild Adventure apply in the event of pupils being withdrawn from the trip, which are as follows:

More than 56 days prior to Arrival Date - First Deposit only payable

56 - 29 days prior to Arrival Date - 60% payable

28 - 15 days prior to Arrival Date - 80% payable

14 - 1 days prior to Arrival Date - 100% payable

A pupil may only be withdrawn from this trip by written confirmation from the parent / carer. A receipt will be issued to you confirming the place has been cancelled and the date of the receipt will be the date that the above charges become applicable.
