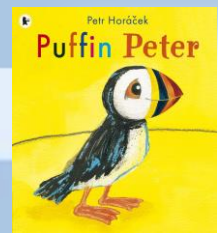


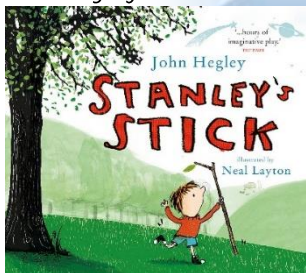
English



Our first rich text of the year will be 'Puffin Peter' by Petr Horáček. We will be focusing on our spoken language skills by using role play and recounting events in chronological order. We will build upon our learning of

sentence structure and punctuation and think about writing our own story.

Our next rich text this half term will be 'Stanley's Stick' by the John Hegley. We will continue to focus on our use of capital letters and full stops to write a sentence independently. Following this, we will begin to use conjunctions to join two clauses together.



Monster Phonics

Phonics: We will continue using Monster Phonics to help us to segment and blend words when we are reading. We will continue to focus on reading our high frequency words to help us with our fluency.

Understanding the World

History: We will be learning about the events of WW2 and thinking about why we have Remembrance Day. We will also be taking part on our Remembrance Day assembly.



RE: We will be learning about Diwali, the festival of light and how Hindus celebrate. As Christmas approaches, we will be learning about why Christians celebrate Christmas and what advent is. We will also be putting on our Nativity performance.

Maths

Number: We will be using the knowledge learnt in Autumn 1 about our number bonds to 10 to focus on addition and subtraction. This will involve using different methods to solve addition and subtraction number sentences, including using concrete objects and number lines.

Understanding Science and Technology

Science: We will start learning about the human body as a continuation of our animals, including humans and their habitats around the world. We will also consider how the seasons change and describe the weather associated with the change from autumn to winter.



DT: We will be learning about how to cut, shape and join a range of paper-materials in order to create a basket for our hot air balloon project.

Computing: Linking with our instruction writing in English, we are going to learn about what algorithms are and beginning to think about how to debug our algorithms.

Understanding Arts and Culture

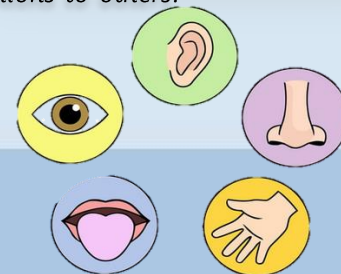

Music and Performing Arts: We will be learning how to use our voices to sing expressively and develop our performance skills in our Nativity.

PE: We will be continuing with our gymnastics unit this half term, as well as sessions to develop our motor control and movement skills. We will learn how to put moves together to create a fluid sequence.

PSHE: We will be learning about 'celebrating differences' that make us special and unique and discussing our right to have different interests and opinions to others.
