Music: We will explore music from other cultures to work on 'call and response' and improvisation skills. .

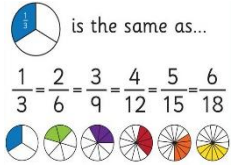
Art: We will be developing our artistic skills by researching Monet and Impressionism.

English

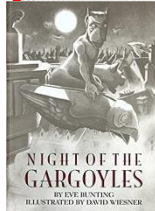
Poetry: We will be learning about the structure of poetry and writing cinquains based on Remembrance.
