Sandhya's Story

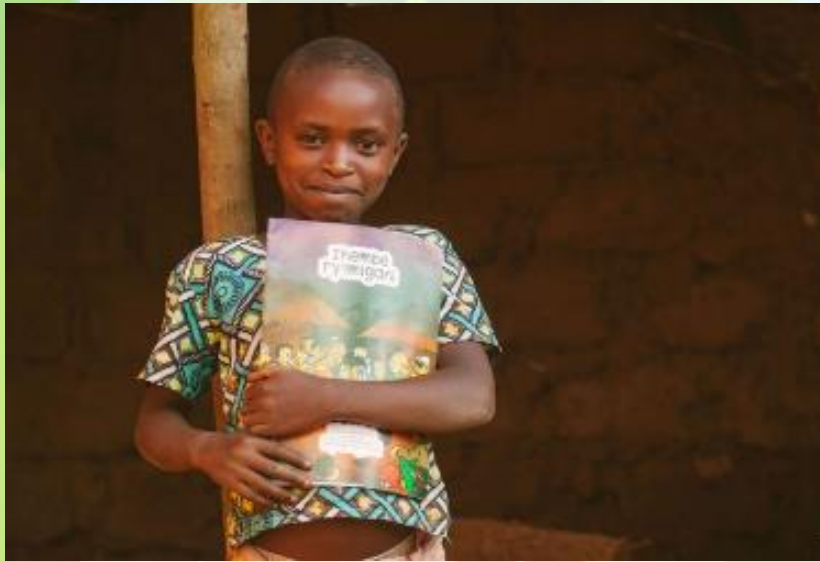
