Main discussion points	Miss Coleman explained what the 'Rights Respecting Gold Award' is (it is granted to schools that have fully embedded the principles of the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child into their ethos and curriculum) which is what we are aiming to achieve again this year.

Each class to choose a name for the elf (from a pre-determined list of names) and then a name will be chosen through a randomly generated wheel during assembly on Friday. • Take an 'elfie! - Each class to take (staged) selfies, including safe photos.
