English

Fly, Eagle, Fly!: We will explore this wonderful fable and use it as inspiration for describing what the eagle can see on its maiden flight.

The Iron Man: We will read this classic tale. We will use the story of asking for help from an unlikely hero to inspire our own narrative.

When writing, we will focus on developing the detail across the sequence of events

Spelling: We will continue to work on our Year 4 spelling list which will include looking at words ending with the /g/ sound spelt -gue We will also be reading a range of texts that link to our topic.



Maths

Multiplication and Division: We will be multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1000. We will use this to help us multiply larger numbers. Length and Perimeter: We will explore finding the perimeter of rectilinear shapes and polygons.

Understanding the World

History: We will be learning about a selection of monarchs who changed the UK and shaped the nation that we live in today.

RE: We will be exploring a selection of creation stories and looking at how different religions explain how the Earth came to be.

Spanish: We will be learning how to talk about different types of houses.

Understanding Science and Technology

Science: Our final unit of the year is 'Electricity'. We will be sorting appliances based on whether they use mains or batteries, explaining how a switch turns the electric current on and off and creating a simple series. DT: We will be exploring our inner fashion designers. We will talk about the purpose of clothing and design an outfit suitable for a very royal (historic) customer.

Computing: We will be starting our audio editing work. We will be working towards recording our own podcasts.
