Until I Met Dudley: In this non-fiction unit, we will look at how instruction texts are structured and how specific vocabulary is used for sequencing ideas.

Beowulf: We will read this classic tale. We will use it to learn more about Viking life and write our own quest for the heroic Beowulf to undertake.

Spelling: We will continue to work on our Year 4 spelling list which will include looking at word families based on common words.

We will also be reading a range of texts that link to our topic.



Maths

Fractions: We will start our fractions work by working with mixed numbers before moving onto improper fractions. We will add fractions with the same denominator.

Decimals: We will be working with tenths before dividing one- and two-digit numbers by 10.



Understanding the World

History: We will be learning about what life was like in Anglo-Saxon times. We will be exploring food, drink and entertainment.

RE: We will be discovering the key beliefs held by Muslims. We will look at the main features of a mosque and explore the main festivals.

Spanish: We will be learning how to talk about the resources in our classroom.
