English

Roman Myths: In this unit, we will explore the effect of figurative language before adding detail to our writing using similes and metaphors.

Alice in Wonderland: We will read this classic tale and learn about the specific features of playscripts.

Spelling: We will continue to work on our Year 4 spelling list which will include looking at words with the suffix '-ly' that end in 'y', 'le' and 'ic'.

We will also be reading a range of texts that link to our topic.



Maths

Time: We convert between analogue and digital time before converting 24-hour time.

Geometry: We will be comparing and ordering angles before looking at the special properties of different polygons.

Statistics: First we will look at a range of charts and interpret the data they present. Then, we will look specifically at line graph data before drawing our own.



Art: We will finish our Andy Warhol pop art unit by creating self-portraits.

Music: We will be learning about the language of music through playing the glockenspiel.




Understanding Science and Technology
