
English

We will be starting this term with a focus on non-fiction texts. We will be learning all about bats and other nocturnal animals we might find at the bottom of the garden. We will first focus on reading these texts and thinking about the features, before writing our own

non-chronological reports. We will then finish the term by learning how to write instructions where we will be reading the book 'How to Catch a Star' by Oliver Jeffers. We will also continue with our guided reading sessions, which will focus on reading comprehension and fluency.





Phonics: We will continue using Monster Phonics help us to segment and blend words when we are reading. We will continue to focus on reading our high frequency words to help us with our fluency.

Understanding Arts and Culture

Music: In music this half term, we will be creating and following music based on our classroom setting. We will using our Geography knowledge to follow a classroom musical key, and then create our own music using classroom resources.

Maths

This term our Number focus will be between 50-100. We will be recapping knowledge around number lines, one more and one less, and finding the tens and ones in a number.

We will then be focusing on measuring – money and time. We will work on recognising and using coins and notes, and then we will be finding times on a clock, to the hour and half past the hour.
