School Meals

KS2 children - A reminder that school meals are £3.00 per day, or £15.00 per week, unless your child is in receipt of Free School Meals. Ordering your child's lunches and payments are to be made via SchoolGrid. Please note - children's meals MUST be paid for in advance, unless you have set up a direct debit with SchoolGrid. SchoolGrid - If your child is absent from school due to illness, it is the parent's responsibility to cancel their own child's lunch by 8.50am on the day, otherwise you may incur a charge for the meal. Special Dietary Requirements - Please be advised that if your child has any special dietary requirements, you will need to apply for a special menu for your child directly through Hertfordshire Catering Limited (HCL). REMINDER - Due to some of our children having severe nut allergies, please do not put items in your child's packed lunch box that contains nuts, this includes Nutella.

If you have ordered or wish to purchase uniform, this will be available from the Community Room between 9.00am and 3.00pm on Thursday 31st August and Friday 1st September 2023 - only the pedestrian gate by the zebra crossing will be open.



Pupil medication - If your child/ren has an inhaler/creams in school, parents will be given these on Friday 21st July 2023 when the children finish. Other medicines WILL NEED TO BE COLLECTED from the school office. Please ensure in-date medication is returned to the school office on Monday 4th September 2023- you will also be required to complete a new medical form. Thank you.

Free School Meals - Year 2 to Year 3 - If your child is moving from Year 2 into Year 3 in September and you believe that your child is entitled to free school meals, you will need to re-apply as entitlement is not automatically renewed. Please apply online now at www.hertfordshire.gov.uk/freeschoolmeals to ensure that your child's free school meal entitlement is in place for September 2023.
