

Understanding the World

History: We will be exploring the Mayans and comparing life then to life today.

RE: We will be exploring the idea of salvation. We will focus on the Easter story and what Christians believe about Jesus' life and the crucifixion.

Spanish: We will be continuing to develop our listening and reading skills around the topic of Habitats.

Understanding Arts and Culture

Music: We will be learning to use the standard musical notation of crotchet, minim and semibreve to indicate how many beats to play.

Art: We will be completing our sculpture project and using our sketches of flowers to inspire our clay sculptures.

Maths

Daily Fluency: We will spend time every day working on our core arithmetic skills for mental calculation strategies.

Statistics: We will be learning how to construct and read information from a range of graphs, including bar charts, line graphs and pie charts.

Fractions: We will be learning how to multiply and divide fractions and solve word problems.



English

Persuasion: We will be exploring the use of persuasion in writing. We will explore advertisements and how language can be used to persuade others.

Reading: We will be working on expanding our vocabulary looking at synonyms and antonyms.

Grammar: We will be learning how to identify and use the main clause, subordinate clause and relative clause in our writing.

Spellings: We will be revising spelling strategies from KS2 and practising dictation tests.

PE: We will be developing our gymnastic skills; focusing on core strength and stability of movements.

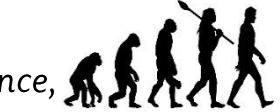
PSHE: We will be learning about Healthy me. This will include how drugs and alcohol affect the body and how to keep ourselves safe.
