



Understanding the World

Geography: We will be learning about Spanish speaking countries around the world and researching their human and natural features. We will be using our map skills using atlases to revise continents and countries.

RE: We will be learning to reflect on ethics. Linking to our evolution learning this term, we will be looking at creation and science together.

Spanish: We will be learning to about the unit 'Me in My World' and will practise using our vocabulary in longer sentences and paragraphs.

Understanding Arts and Culture

Music: We will be learning to sing in tune in preparation for our Year 6 play! They children will practise singing in different parts and learn about tempo and pitch.

Art: We will be learning about 3D sculpture and creating models based on the human form using wire, fabric and paper. We will be inspired by Olympic athletes movement and the work of the artist Degas.



Maths

Daily Fluency: We will spend time each week working on arithmetic skills for mental calculation strategies.

Calculation: We will revise all our core calculation methods to ensure we are completely secure in these ready for secondary school. We will be learning to solve problems involving ratio and proportion

English

We will be preparing the children's favourite pieces of writing this year for them to publish in their best handwriting for their secondary schools. They are excited to impress their new teachers!

Speaking and Listening: We will be spending lots of time on our play this half term. We will be learning to recite lines of my heart, use expression and intonation in our voices and work on our comedic timing! We will also be practising our acting skills on stage.
