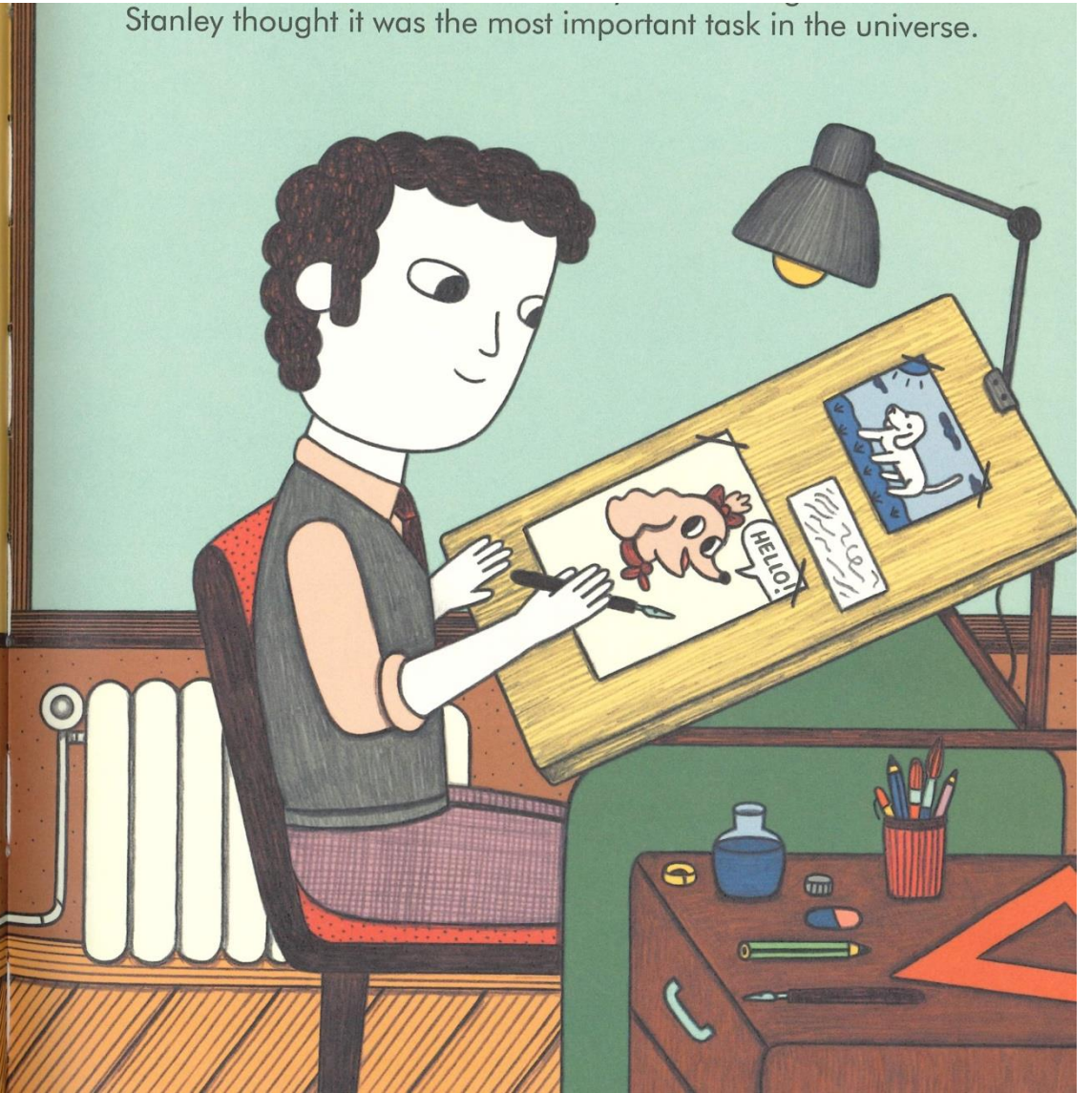

one day this name would be famous.

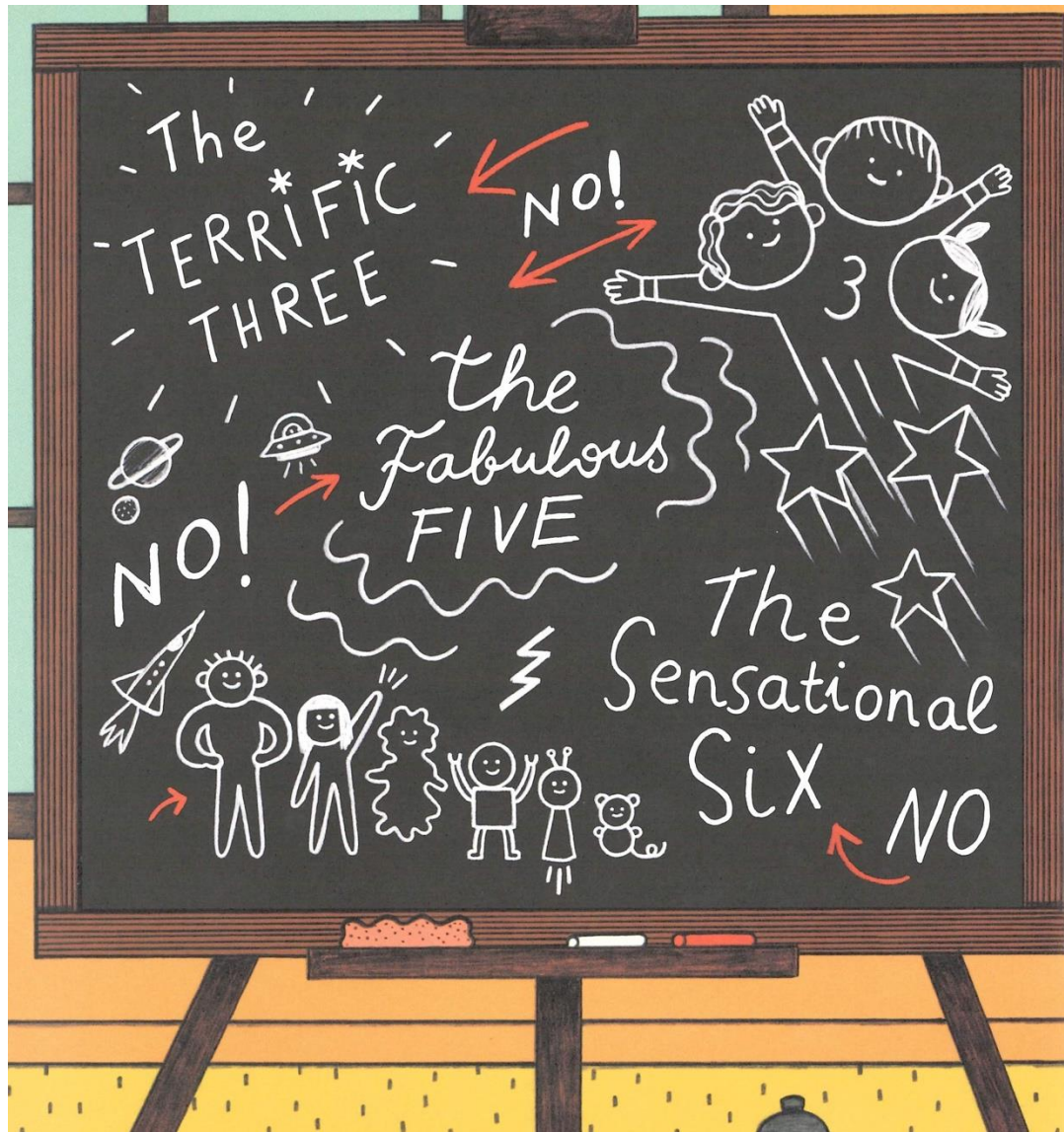

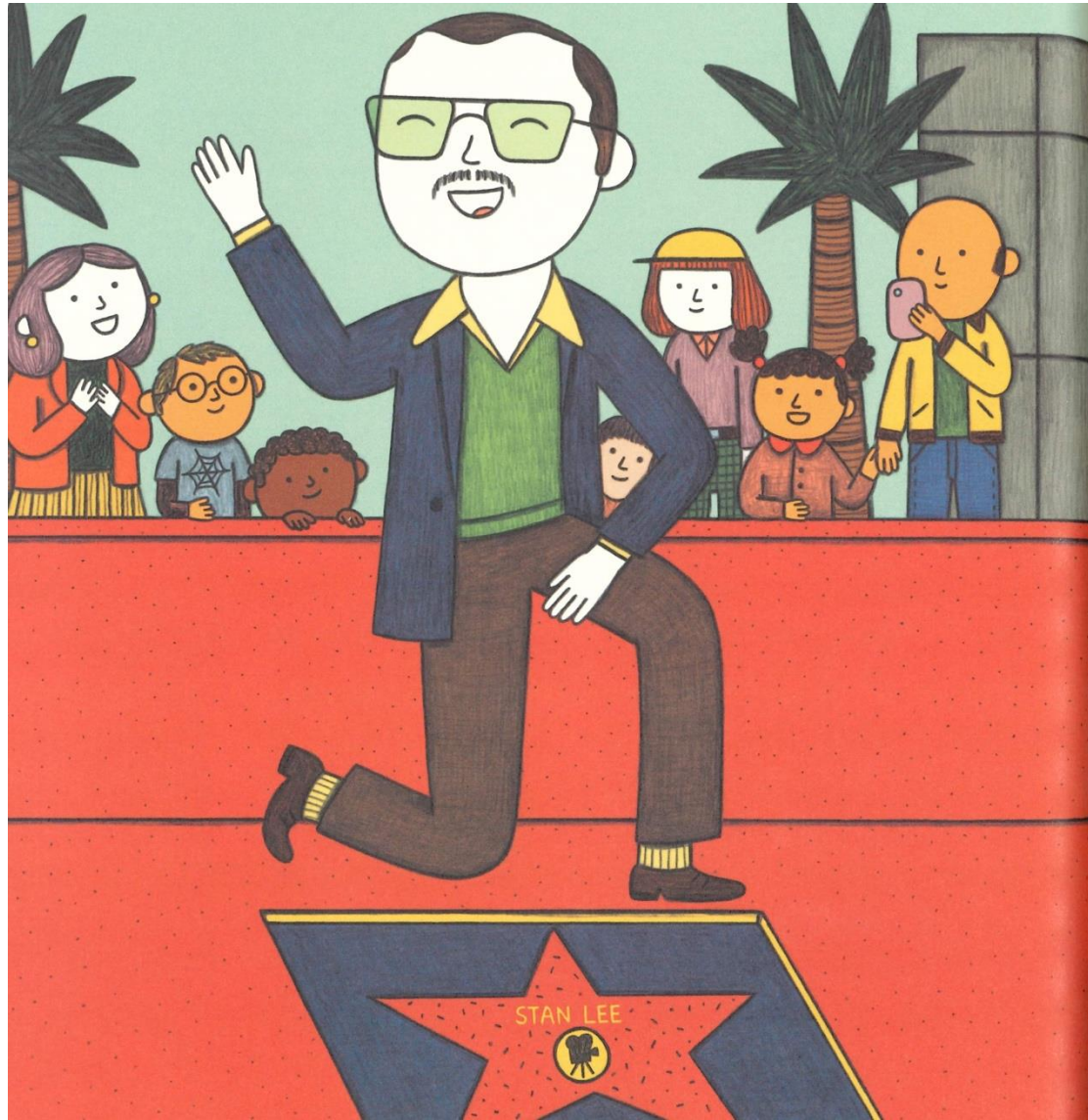
