English

Our next book for our focussed English learning will be 'The Great Fire of London.' This text will support us to prioritise the key grammar skills we are still securing. We will be punctuating single and multi clause sentences using full stops, capital letters, and using the co-ordinating

letters, and using the co-ordinating conjunctions or, and, but. We will be conveying information in non narrative forms and learning how to proof read for errors in spelling, punctuation and grammar.



Phonics: We will continue to follow the Monster Phonics programme to reinforce our knowledge of all phonemes and graphemes. We will begin to learn spelling rules and learn about prefixes and suffixes.

Understanding the World

History: This term, we will be looking at the Great Fire of London. We will think about what life was like in London in the 17th Century and the differences between life now and then.

RE: We will exploring symbols and actions which express religious meaning. We will be looking at religious celebrations from varying religions, including the Nativity and Diwali.


Maths



This half term we will be moving on to addition and subtraction. We will start with addition, thinking about crossing the tens barrier when we add. We will then look at the same for subtraction. We will then look at a range of different methods for adding and subtracting 2-digit numbers to 1-digit. We will finish the half term with some work on shapes, looking at properties of both 2D and 3D shapes.

Understanding Arts and Culture



DT: This half term will be learning about mechanisms and use key vocabulary to design and evaluate a product.
