

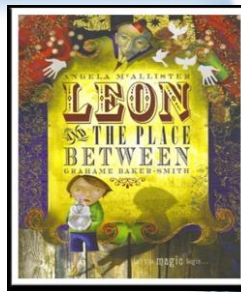

Fiction: We will continue to learn how to write a recount using our fantastically magical text...

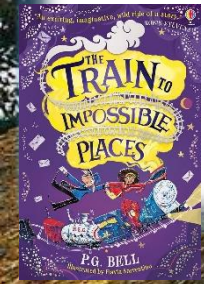
'Leon and The Place Between'.

Maths

Place Value: We will continue our addition and subtraction units, learning how to add and subtract 4-digit numbers with multiple regroupings or exchanges.

We will then move on to choosing the most efficient methods of problem solving. As we move closer to Christmas, we will learn about measurement and how to solve measuring problems and puzzles.

Time tables are still a HUGE priority for us in Year 4 and we will continue with daily counting and multiplication sessions in addition to our maths lessons.

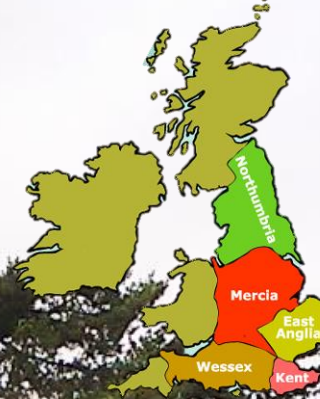
