We will continue with our text called 'Where the Forest Meets the Sea' where we are looking at past, present and future tenses, expanded noun phrases and fronted adverbials. We will explore new vocabulary and suggest ways of using these words ourselves in our own writing.

We will then finish the year by looking at Shakespeare and modern versions of some of his most famous plays.



Maths

Decimals: We will continue our learning of decimals and link with our earlier fraction topic. We will compare decimals, divide and multiply by 100 and add/subtract decimals.

Geometry: We will be comparing and ordering angles before looking at the special properties of different polygons.

Statistics: First we will look at a range of charts and interpret the data they present. Then, we will look specifically at line graph data before drawing our own.

Art: We will finish our Andy Warhol pop art unit by creating self-portraits.

Music: We will be learning about the language of music through playing the glockenspiel.
