Understanding our Health and Well-Being

PE: We will be developing our fitness, strength and aiming skills this term with indoor athletics while also learning Country and Western dancing in Dance lessons

PSHCE: Dreams and Goals. We will set ourselves goals and plan how we can achieve them.

Understanding the World

Geography: We will learn about natural disasters and how to prepare for a volcano eruption. We will learn survival techniques and how natural disasters can impact the lives of others.

History: We will explore Roman history by learning about key people and events. We will explore the role of different people on Roman society, including Roman Soldiers.

RE: Identity and Belonging - Belonging to a family, a community; challenges and religious leadership.

Spanish: We will learn how to name fruit, vegetables and explain our likes/dislikes in Spanish.



English

We will exploring the book 'Stone Age Boy' by Satoshi Kitamura *this half term* and learning all about historical fiction. We will look at different features of this book including characters, setting and dialogue. We will then create a historical story based on the Stone Age.

We will continue to use the story to support the deepening of Year 3 grammar, spelling and creative writing skills. We will then use all of these skills to help us write our own version of the story.

Handwriting: We will have daily handwriting sessions that will teach the children correct letter formation, joins and how to use a pen correctly.

Reading: We will be reading the story 'Iron Man' by Ted Hughes. We will be making predictions; clarify vocabulary by exploring meanings of words; retrieving and recording key information and explaining main events and drawing inferences from evidence.



Spellings: We will continue to consolidate our phonics knowledge through Guided reading sessions and learn Year 3 spellings weekly.

Understanding Arts and Culture

Art: We will create volcano prints by explore printing techniques through the work of Hokusai. We will also look at the life of Hokusai and explore a variety of his work and people that he has influenced.

Music:: We will begin to use our exciting new Music curriculum to learn how to follow beats, rhythm and tempo. We will also sing songs in harmony and create our own short musical pieces.

Computing: We will be learning how to use animation to convey a short story or sequence of events.
