Guided Reading

Maths

Fractions: We will reactivate our fractions knowledge from Year 3 before exploring how to convert mixed number to improper fractions (and vice versa).



We will also be focusing on learning the tricky multiplication facts ready for our multiplication checks and find ways to remember and use them.

Understanding the World

Geography: We will be exploring UK counties and cities. Working on our map skills, we will be looking at compass directions, grid references, keys and so much more.
