
English

Writing: We will explore the texts 'Jungle Explorers' and 'Where the Forest Meets the Sea'. We will look at the structure of the texts and the grammar that has been used. We will then use this to inspire our own writing.



Spelling: We will continue to work on our Year 4 spelling list which will include looking at word families based on common words.

Maths

We will continue our learning about fractions, including how to subtract fractions from whole and mixed numbers. We will then move on to learning about decimals, where we will be working with tenths before dividing one- and two- digit numbers by 10.

CRIME AND PUNISHMENT

Understanding the World

History: We will be learning about crime and punishment through the ages. We are going to revisit key periods of history and learn about the ways in which criminals were punished.

RE: We will be discovering the key beliefs held by Muslims. We will look at the main features of a mosque and explore the main festivals.

Spanish: We will be learning how to talk about the resources in our classroom.

Understanding Science and Technology

Science: Sparks will fly with our electricity project this term where we create circuits and investigate materials that are conductors or insulators.

DT: We will be making links to our science topic by creating our own light boxes during our electricity topic.

Computing: After finishing our programming unit, we will be starting our photo editing work. We will be exploring adding effects to photos and how to identify 'fake' images.

Understanding our Health and Well-Being

PE: We will be partaking in gymnastics and netball lessons his half term. We will be focusing on different ways to pass the netball and move up the court, before completing a sequence using apparatus in gymnastics.

PSHCE: We will be learning about 'Relationships' and what a positive relationship looks like.

Music: In music, we will be composing for percussion where children will use notation to compose music for an instrument of their choice.
