Re: Year 2 visit to Johnsons of Old Hurst Zoo, Huntingdon

To support our Science topic on living things and their habitats, we will be visiting Johnsons of Old Hurst Zoo in Huntingdon on **Thursday 3rd July 2025**.

We will be leaving school at 9.00am shortly after registration and will be returning back to school for 4.30pm. Please collect your child from their outside classroom door – only the main pedestrian gate will be open for collecting children.

Children will need to bring a packed lunch and plenty of drink for the whole day (no fizzy drinks or glass bottles please). Please ensure that your child's packed lunch is provided in a named disposable bag which can be thrown away after the children have finished eating. **If your child receives benefit entitled free school meals (NOT universal FSM), the school can provide a packed lunch (cheese roll) for them, but this must be pre-ordered via SchoolGrid by Monday 30th June 2025.**

Children should be in school uniform and will also need a waterproof coat and sturdy shoes. Children do not need to bring any spending money.



The cost of the trip will be £15.00 which will go towards the cost of the coaches and entrance fee, the rest of the cost will be met by the school.

Please ensure that you register consent and make payment of £15 online at www.schoolgateway.com by **Tuesday 1st July** – this is located in the payments section of Schoolgateway titled 'Year 2 Trip to Johnsons of Old Hurst Zoo'.

Please note that we will be unable to take your child on this trip if consent/payment has not been made.
