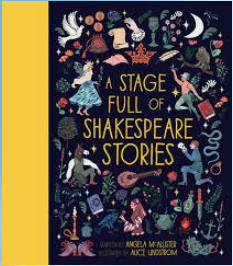


English

We will finish the year by looking at Shakespeare and modern versions of some of his most famous plays including Julius Caesar. We will be exploring the book 'A Stage Full of Shakespeare Stories' by Angela McAllister. We will continue to follow our Superhero Spelling scheme to cover the remainder of spelling rules for Year Four.



Maths

Decimals: We will continue our learning of decimals and link with our earlier fraction topic. We will compare decimals, divide and multiply by 100 and add/subtract decimals.

Geometry: We will be comparing and ordering angles before looking at the special properties of different polygons.

Statistics: First we will look at a range of charts and interpret the data they present. Then, we will look specifically at line graph data before drawing our own.

Understanding Arts and Culture

Music: We will be composing for percussion in Music this term.



Understanding Science and Technology

Science: We will be learning all about sound, how our ears are designed to hear and differences in pitch and volume.

DT: We will be completing our Fashion Designing project where we will be developing our work with textiles.

Computing: We will be exploring our Photo Editing project.

Understanding our Health and Well-Being

PE: We will be getting ready for Sports Day this term by practicing our running and other athletic skills. We will also be developing our skills in tennis.

PSHE: We will be learning about 'Changing Me'. We will talk about physical differences between males and females as they grow up and how we feel about changes that are out of our control.

Understanding the World

Geography: We will be exploring the key human and physical characteristics of the UK.

RE: We will be discovering the key beliefs held by Christians about Jesus. We will look at how he is presented in different bible stories.

Spanish: We will be learning how to talk about the resources in our classroom.
