School Meals

KS2 children - The price of a school meal is £3.45 per day, £17.25 per week, unless your child is in receipt of Free School Meals. Ordering your child's lunches and payments are to be made via SchoolGrid. **Please note** - children's meals **MUST** be paid for in advance, unless you have set up a direct debit with SchoolGrid. **SchoolGrid** - If your child is absent from school due to illness, it is the parent's responsibility to cancel their own child's lunch by 8.50am on the day, otherwise you may incur a charge for the meal.

Special Dietary Requirements - Please be advised that if your child has any special dietary requirements, you will need to apply for a special menu for your child directly through Hertfordshire Catering Limited (HCL). Special menus available include Dairy Free, Vegan, Egg Free & Vegetarian, Pork Free, Beef Free, Beef & Pork Free and Pescetarian. To apply, simply go to <https://specialmenu.hcl.co.uk>

REMINDER - Due to some of our children having severe nut allergies, please do not put items in your child's packed lunch box that contains nuts, this includes Nutella.

Parents will be able to order more uniform in September 2025. Thank you.

Free School Meals - If your child is moving from Year 2 into Year 3 in September and you believe that your child is entitled to free school meals, you will need to re-apply as entitlement is not automatically renewed. Please apply online now at www.hertfordshire.gov.uk/freeschoolmeals to ensure that your child's free school meal entitlement is in place for September 2025.



Outstanding Payments - Please can we ask all parents to ensure overdue payments for school meals, breakfast club, after school club and school trips are paid by **Friday 18th July 2025** at the latest. Thank you.

School Reports - School reports will be emailed to parents the **week commencing 14th July 2025**. If you wish to request a hard copy of your child's report, please do so in September 2025. Year 6 will receive a paper version of their school report.

Pupil medication - If your child/ren has an inhaler/creams in school, parents will be given these on **Friday 18th July 2025** when the children finish. Other medicines **WILL NEED TO BE COLLECTED** from the school office. **Please ensure in-date medication is returned to the school office on Thursday 4th September 2025** - you will also be required to complete a new medical form.

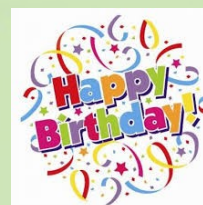
