bed.

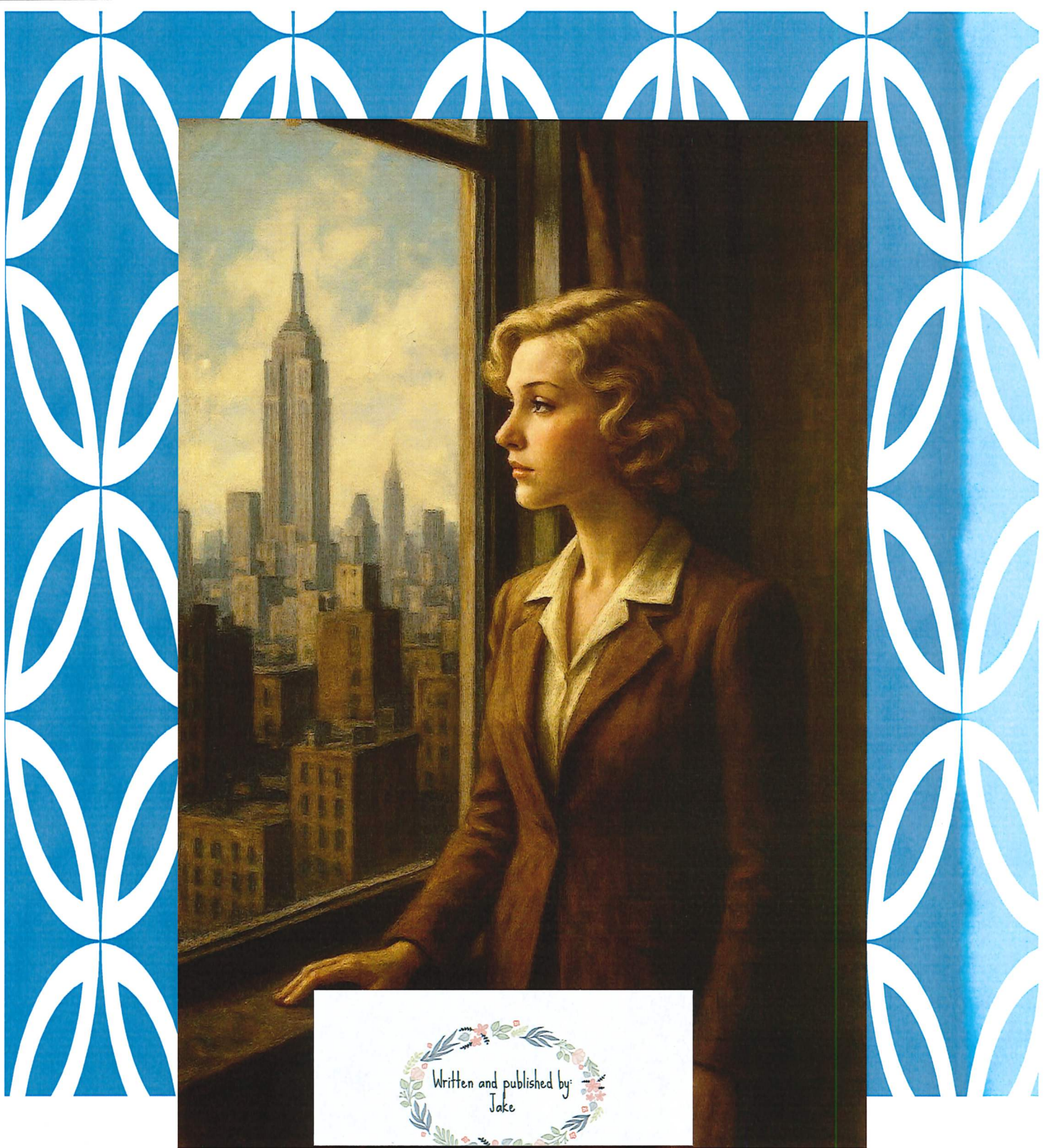
Dear diary,
