### English

Our first rich text of the year is 'Lost Found' by Oliver Jeffers. This book we take us on a journey through the South Pole to help a little boy return a lost penguin. We will be focusing on combining words to make a sentence and using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops to write an adventure story.

#### **Phonics**

This term, we will continue our exciting phonics journey using the Monster Phonics scheme. Children will be introduced to new graphemes (letters and groups of letters that represent sounds) and will build on their skills in segmenting and blending words. These key skills help support both reading and spelling development. We will also be learning high frequency words to help improve reading fluency and confidence. As part of the White Rose Maths scheme, we will be exploring place value, focusing on: sorting, counting, comparing and ordering. We will develop our knowledge of addition and subtraction (up to 10) using number bonds and part whole models. We will continue to identify and name common 2D and 3D shapes and their properties.

### Understanding the World

Geography: We will begin our 'UK Project' identifying weather types in the UK and explaining some dangers in weather. We will use maps and globes to identify the UK and begin to locate its neighbouring countries.

RE: We will explore how Christians and others celebrate Harvest around the world. Then, we will learn about justice and fairness and why rules are important.

## Understanding Science and Technology

**Science:** Our first topic is 'The Human Body'. We will identify features of our bodies and explore our senses.

We will learn about seasonal changes during autumn, looking at the variation in the length of days and the changes we observe. Then, we will explore the use of everyday materials.

Computing: We will begin our 'BeeBot Project', learning to navigate them towards a target using simple algorithms. We will use maps to take a journey around London and visit key landmarks.

### Understanding Arts and Culture

Art: We will be experimenting with colour mixing and a range of different media to create wonderful pieces of artwork, inspired by Piet Mondrian.

Music: We will be learning how to - use voices expressively in a range of Christmas songs, in preparation for our year group Nativity.

### Understanding Health and Wellbeing

**PE**: We will be focusing on our coordination and control in gymnastics, looking at how we move in our spaces and handling equipment safely.

**PSHE**: We will be learning how to make our classroom a safe place for everyone to learn and understanding choices and consequences.
