

English

Our Tower is the first text that we will be using in Year 4 this term. This will explore the differences between the characters in the book and our own lives. We will explore the text and look at different grammar techniques that we can mimic in our own story.

In Guided reading, we will be looking **Fantastic Forests** and exploring the features of non-fiction texts.

Spelling: We will continue to work on our Year 4 spelling list and using Super Hero Spellings to help us to learn spelling rules.

We will also be reading a range of texts that link to our topic.

Maths

Multiplication and Division: We will begin by revisiting the multiplication facts that we have already explored along with learning about factors and multiples. We will use factors to help us solve larger multiplication problems. We will be multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1000 before moving on to explore fractions.

Things are hotting up with our TTRockstar challenges too, ready for the Multiplication check in the summer term.

Understanding the World

History: We will be learning about what life was like in Anglo-Saxon and Viking times. We will also look at how the two fought for the kingdom of England.

RE: We will be exploring a selection of creation stories and looking at how different religions explain how the Earth came to be.

Spanish: We will be learning how to present ourselves in Spanish.

Understanding Science and Technology

Science: We will be investigating living things and their habitats through fun and practical activities. We will explore and use classification keys to help us group and identify a variety of living things in our local and wider environment. Computing: We will be looking at programming this half term with a focus on constructing shapes.

Music: We will be starting a new music topic, looking at piano skills. We will also be learning different notations in music.
