


## English

This half term we will be reading a book called 'Major Glad, Major Dizzy' and using it to write a diary entry from the perspective of different characters. We will be using verbs in the past and present tense and the spelling rules that link with these. Throughout the topic we will be thinking about the key punctuation that is needed in our sentences and we will use conjunctions to extend our sentences and add more detail.



## Phonics

We will continue to follow the Monster Phonics programme to reinforce our knowledge of all phonemes and graphemes. We will focus predominantly on spelling rules and introduce a range of grammatical terminology.



## Maths


This half term, we will be looking at multiplication and division. We will focus mainly on the 2, 5 and 10 times tables. We will look at doubling and halving, as well as using a range of resources, such as arrays, to solve problems.

We will then move on to looking at measure including length and capacity. We will learn how to measure in centimetres, metres, grams and kilograms. We will then learn how to compare and calculate basic measurements.



## Understanding Arts and Culture

Music: In Music this half term we will be focusing on exploring sounds. We will be exploring different percussion instruments and exploring music from around the world.



## Understanding our Health and Well-Being

PE: In PE this term we will be learning about net games. We will be learning to use a racket and develop our skills when hitting and returning a ball. We will then move on to playing against an opponent at the end of the term.

PSHE: Our topic this half term is 'Healthy Me.' We will think about why it is important to keep our bodies healthy and ways that we can do this. We will look at the different food groups, the meaning of a healthy lifestyle and activities we like to do to relax.

## Understanding the World

History: We will be completing a project about significant individuals who have contributed to international change, such as, Florence Nightingale and Mary Seacole and the contributions they both made to medicine.

RE: In RE, we will be exploring the importance of Easter for Christians and why it is celebrated. We will explore the meaning of Lent and how Mothering Sunday originated from Lent period.

## Understanding Science and Technology

Science: Our Science topic this half term continues with 'Materials' with a focus on plastic. We will also be conducting experiments involving different materials and learning about making predictions and fair tests.

DT: In Design Technology, we will be looking at our textiles project. We will learn how to thread and sew to create our own ocean themed textile. Our fine motor skills will come into play and we will focus on developing our cutting and shaping of materials too.
